Notes from the nursery Orders

- City of Kingston has ordered ~ 400 plants to supplement planting at the Grange.
- Lyndale Primary School have ordered 250 for their planting in wetlands near Dandenong Creek.
- Greater Dandenong has collected all of their order plus some more plants.

They have also supplied some cool season seed for sowing next year.

- City of Kingston contractors have collected plants for Mavis Hutter Reserve and returned a mountain of poly boxes and many tubes.
- Plants keep disappearing from the Kingswood Golf Course order — presumably they're going in!
- Metro GC have ordered ALL our remaining *Stipa mollis* in addition to their existing order.

Propagation

- Sowing *Stipa mollis*, *Pattersonia occidentalis*, *ozothamnus*, more grasses, *Banksia marginata*, *Hakea nodosa*.
- Cuttings: *Goodenia ovata*, *Correa reflexa*, *aotus* and *pimelia*.
- Dividing some *lepidosperma*.
- Pricking out *arthropodium*, *bursaria*, *viminaria* and *juncus*
